RECOGNITION BY DOVER SCHOOL BOARD

It shall be the policy of the School Board to recognize those who have made a significant and lasting contribution to the Dover school system which is worthy of special recognition.

Names of persons to be nominated must be presented by a School Board member. The presentation will include a brief resume of the justification for recognition.

The name of each nominee will be presented by the chairperson in executive session at the next School Board meeting.

After discussion of the justification for recognition, a consensus will be reached as to whether to proceed. If the Board agrees to recognize the person nominated, the chairperson will refer the name to the School Board Recognition Committee.

The Recognition Committee will decide an appropriate form of recognition for the person nominated (e.g., school, field, room, plaque, etc.). At that time, a formal proposal will be made to the full School Board at its next regular executive session. This proposal should include the particulars of the type of recognition and the ceremony planned.

If the Board agrees with the Recognition Committee proposal, the School Board chairperson will contact the person prior to the next regularly scheduled School Board meeting in order to assure his/her willingness to accept the honor.

The final vote to recognize a person of distinction by the Dover School Board shall be by a two-thirds vote of all members of the committee at that time.

The formal vote will be taken as prescribed about at the next regular School Board meeting.
