ANNUAL MEETING/REPORT CARD

The intent of this policy is to provide the Dover School Board and the public with a complete view of the status of education in the Dover School District.

The Dover School Board recognizes that only through knowledge can the district change to meet the needs of its students and staff.

The Dover School Board shall conduct an annual meeting, and administrators shall review the past, current, and projected status and goals of education in Dover schools. This meeting shall be public and televised. The administration shall provide and explain to the public and the School Board data and information including, but not limited to, the following:

- State and national test scores
- Reading tests/reading skill levels district-wide
- Results of local performance standards
- College entrance scores
- Population growth
- Dropout rates
- Two-year and four-year college entrance data
- Results of curriculum implementation
- Efforts and data on truancy
- General behavior trends/discipline issues
- Improvement Plan, if necessary

The administration shall provide an historic perspective on all items presented for discussion.

It shall be incumbent upon the administration to include a simple narrative summary for all data provided.

It shall be required that administrators review areas of significant weakness and strength in presenting the current status of education in the Dover School District.

In a simple narrative form the administration shall present plans for dealing with those areas that require improvement.

At this meeting the Superintendent shall establish, print, distribute, and present a “graded report card” on the district’s performance year to year.
